→ "Unpredictable, neverthless usefull!"



#### Interview with ELE student

#### What would you recommend new students?

→ "Make sure your insurance is truly valid. I had the European Health Insurance Card, which, apparently gets invalid if you register your living place to another location from where it was issued originally.



- → "The first few semesters will seem very easy, but the difficulty exponentially increases. So don't go in to the class with a mindset of ,this is too easy', because when the course gets hard, its easy to get lost.
- → If you are really lost don't be afraid to ask the professor and have available content next to you (books, informational videos, whatever you use to study), if you are behind you need to learn more on your own.




