What would you recommend new students?

- 
- *„**Make sure your insurance is truly valid.** I had the European Health Insurance Card, which, apparently gets invalid if you register your living place to another location from where it was issued originally.*
 - *„The first few semesters will seem very easy, but the difficulty exponentially increases. So **don't go in to the class with a mindset of ,this is too easy'**, because when the course gets hard, its easy to get lost.*
 - *If you are really lost - **don't be afraid to ask the professor** and have available content next to you (books, informational videos, whatever you use to study), if you are behind you need to **learn more on your own.***

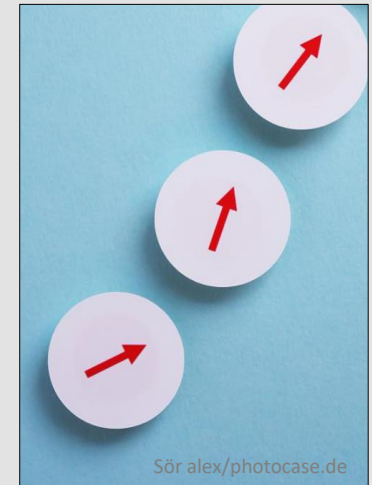

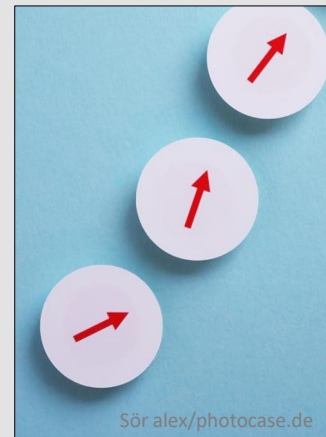

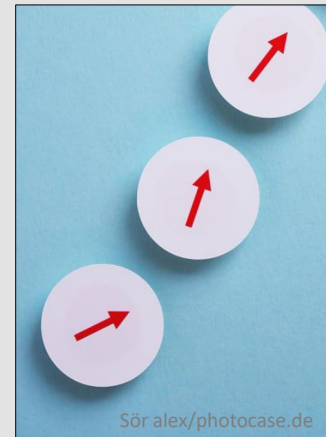
