

Call for Applications for the Lippstadt Campus **The Deutschlandstipendium 2025/26 of the Hamm-Lippstadt University of Applied Sciences**

Hamm-Lippstadt University of Applied Sciences is once again offering Deutschlandstipendium Scholarships for the 2025/26 winter semester.

In addition to the 8* scholarships for the Lippstadt campus that have already been approved and renewed from last year, we will be offering a further 16 scholarships.

The Deutschlandstipendium, which is jointly funded by the federal government and private sponsors, provides talented students with (income-independent) financial support.

It is not only outstanding school and/or university results or previous work performance that count, but also the personal achievements to date:

Have you received awards or prizes for special achievements? Or are you particularly involved in social, communal or political organizations?

Consideration is also given to overcoming specific biographical challenges and obstacles resulting from family or cultural background (e.g., a single parent or previously entirely self-funded).

Eligible to apply are students of the Hamm-Lippstadt University of Applied Sciences. The prerequisite for the scholarship is the enrollment at the Hamm-Lippstadt University of Applied Sciences.

Funding Requirements

The basic prerequisite for the financial structure of the planned scholarships is the acquisition of private funds, which will then be supplemented by public funds. The Deutschlandstipendium is awarded for a period of one year, from 1 October of the year in which it is granted (retroactive payment) to September 30 of the following year. The monthly amount of the scholarship is 300 euros. Scholarships are awarded for one year at a time, and may be renewed if the applicant provides demonstrates positive performance.

Even if you receive BAföG, you can still be supported by the Deutschlandstipendium!

Applications

The next round of the Deutschlandstipendium will be awarded in the winter semester 2025/26.

Applications must be received by the scholarship officers by **14 November 2025.**

The scholarship officer for the Lippstadt Campus is Prof. Dr. Sabine Hollmann.

We expect a written application that includes the following documents:

- Letter of motivation
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form
- Transcript of Records (can be printed out directly from your student account in the online campus portal; only required for the 2nd semester and above)
- Diploma from high school /technical college
- Proof of additional qualifications, awards, prizes, social commitment, etc.

In addition, you will need to complete and submit the application forms: Scholarship Application (Bewerbungsformular), Application Details and Declaration of Consent (Einverständniserklärung). The documents are available (German language only) in the “Stipendien” course on the learning platform:

Selection process

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of talent, achievement and criteria such as personal background and social commitment in accordance with the guidelines for the awarding of Deutschlandstipendium.

If the number of potential applicants exceeds the number of scholarships to be awarded, a ranking list will be established. If necessary, there will be a succession process.

The scholarship officer will notify applicants of their results.

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
