

	Attend the welcome event for your study program and participate in the safety briefing! All first-year students from Hamm and Lippstadt will be informed about the dates during the welcome event of their study program or in the course of the first weeks via the learning platform.
	Download your curriculum from the learning platform In the courses "Scheduling Hamm" or "Scheduling Lippstadt" you can download your curriculum at my.HSHL.de via the learning platform.
	Register in tutorial groups About two weeks prior to the start of the semester, the group assignments will gradually be activated in the communication course of your study program on the learning platform. There you can also see the respective start time from when yo can exactly register in the groups.
	Register for exams If your enrollment at HSHL is complete and you have already received your certificate of enrollment, you can register for the exams of the winter semester. If you wish to register after the registration period has expired, please contact the Campus Office by e-mail. Registration deadlines are published on the website: hshl.de/en/all-semester-dates. You can register for exams online in your student account, which can be found in Campus Office Online and accessed via my.HSHL.de. There you will also find instructions.

	Get your DeliCard in the dining hall You can purchase your DeliCard at any time at the cash desk in the dining hall in Hamm or Lippstadt for a deposit of €5. Please present a photo ID and a certificate of study.


First semester & welcome café: info and tips

Intercultural training for international students


Those who come to study in Germany may encounter a completely new culture with different values, communication and general manners. Such differences can lead to misunderstandings or even to frustration. However, experiences have shown, that familiarizing yourself with the peculiarities of German culture and becoming aware of the differences at an early stage makes it easier to adapt to everyday life situations at the university.

For this reason, the International Office invites you to take part in the Intercultural Training for international students. Here you will reflect on cultural characteristics

and learn more about the teaching and learning culture in Germany. You will also be able to develop individual strategies for dealing with cultural confusion and understand the stages of a culture shock. You will receive a certificate of attendance.

Participation is free of charge in most courses and sports offers, all that is required is a short registration. If you would like to offer a sports course


